




An Ordinary Person s Memoir (Revision) (Paperback)

An Ordinary Person s Memoir is a collection of essays that the author, Dr. Jiausen Jih, wrote during his retirement years. It was written in Chinese and consists of seven sections - Family Love, Friendship, Recollection, Travel, Biography, Point of View, and Miscellaneous. The first edition was published in Taiwan in 2010. It was a private publication (not for sale to the public) distributed only to relatives, friends, and libraries - National Central Library of the Republic of China, Academia Historica of the Republic of China, National Taiwan University Library, Taipei Cheng Kung High School Library, the United States Library of Congress, and Montgomery County Public Libraries (Maryland, United States). This is the revised edition; it consists of 100 essays, including 39 newly written and 3 Englishtranslated essays.
