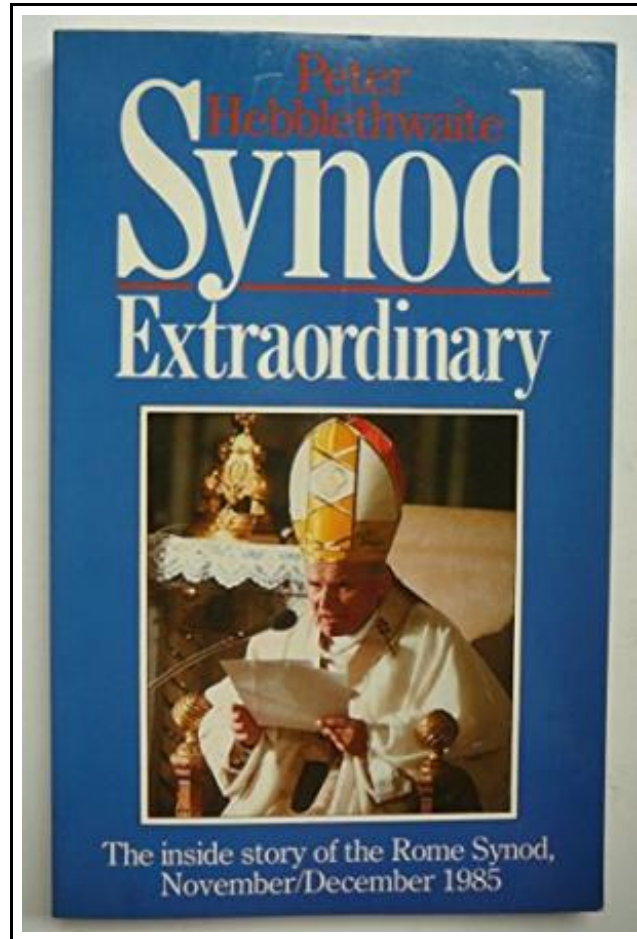

Speculation ran high that this gathering of bishops from around the world would accomplish more than mark the 20th anniversary of the Second Vatican Council. Little information about the internecine activity was revealed to the public, although denunciations of certain theologians and warnings about misinterpretations were issued. Hebblethwaite's version of an institutionally controlled Synod will interest Vatican watchers, setting the scene as it does for an anticipated Synod in 1987. From Library Journal: Hebblethwaite sees the 1985 Synod convened by Pope John Paul II to evaluate the Church's direction since Vatican Council II as a barometer of the Church's organizational climate. This climate is set by the Pope and by Cardinal Ratzinger, head of the Holy Office, who are conservative, authoritarian, and error-seeking. Their agenda of 13 comprehensive questions dealing with such issues as liturgy, moral teaching, and collegiality exacerbated existing conflicts with many Synod participants, who were also dismayed by the limited time frame. However, the author is hopeful that pastoral-minded bishops, led by the Dutch prelates, will hold to the spirit of Vatican II. Though some laypersons might be intrigued, the book's theological terminology and narrow subject matter make it appropriate for specialized religious collections. Nancy M.
